



## UUMC's TCU FOOTBALL SEASON PARKING AGREEMENT

University United Methodist Church ("UUMC") utilizes the parking lots on its property on the days on which TCU has home football games for the purpose of raising money to support the church's Missions and Ministries. In 2017, UUMC will designate assigned spots as Season Parking spaces accessible only to those who make a special gift to these UUMC Ministries.

In consideration of UUMC providing me with a designated parking space (the "Parking Space"), I, \_\_\_\_\_, do agree to and confirm the following:

- I am over the age of twenty-one (21).
- I understand that I am making a non-refundable special gift to the Missions and Ministries of UUMC. To show appreciation for the gift, UUMC is allowing me the privilege of using a Parking Space on TCU home football game days only. The use of the Parking Space is a privilege and can be rescinded at any time by UUMC, at its sole discretion.
- I shall be subject to and will abide by, and shall notify and require my guests and invitees to abide by, the terms and conditions of UUMC's published Game Day Parking Rules and Regulations pertaining to the use of the Parking Space. In addition, I will comply, and cause my guests and invitees to comply, with all applicable present and future laws, ordinances, orders, rules and regulations of any local, state or federal governmental authorities, and shall not permit any violations thereof.
- My guests and invitees and I shall at all times maintain proper decorum while using the Parking Space. I realize that I will be held responsible for all of my actions, as well as those of my guests and invitees. Should I or any of my guests and invitees create a disturbance, UUMC shall have the right to notify the proper authorities and revoke my privilege of access to the Parking Space for the remainder of the season.
- I further agree that the use of the Parking Space will be for the private use of my immediate family, guests and invitees. Any misuse or violation of this agreement or the Game Day Parking Rules and Regulations, which has been provided to me and may be found at [www.uumcfw.com/tcu-parking](http://www.uumcfw.com/tcu-parking), will result in the revocation of my parking pass(es) and associated privileges with no refund of any portion of my special gift.

**I AGREE TO RELEASE, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS UUMC AND ITS STEWARDS, EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS (COLLECTIVELY, THE "INDEMNITEES") OF, FROM AND AGAINST ANY LIABILITY, LOSSES, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, COSTS AND EXPENSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES AND LITIGATION EXPENSES, ARISING FROM THE DEATH OF OR INJURY TO ANY PERSON OR DAMAGE TO ANY PROPERTY WHATSOEVER ARISING FROM OR IN CONNECTION WITH (I) MY OR MY GUESTS OR MY INVITEES USE OF THE PARKING SPACE; (II) ANY BREACH OR CONTRAVENTION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT; (III) MY NEGLIGENCE OR THAT OF MY GUESTS AND INVITEES; OR (IV) THE CONTRAVENTION OF ANY APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS OR ORDERS BY ME OR MY GUESTS OR INVITEES, EVEN IF THE APPLICABLE CLAIM IS CAUSED BY OR RESULTS FROM THE ORDINARY NEGLIGENCE**



**OR FAULT OF ANY ONE OR MORE OF THE INDEMNITEES, BUT NOT THE WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF ANY ONE OF MORE OF THE INDEMNITEES.**

## UUMC Game Day Parking Rules and Regulations

- UUMC is a family centered place for worship. Therefore, we request that you respect our policies that prohibit the consumption of alcohol on our property. UUMC will allow tailgating, that **does not** include alcohol or glass containers, prior to the games.
- Access to the Season Parking Lots will be available no earlier than three (3) hours prior to the published game kick-off time. I also understand that my designated parking space(s) **may not** be available if I arrive later than thirty (30) minutes **before** game kick-off.
- Vehicles, belongings, and trash must be removed from the Season Parking Lot no later than the earlier of midnight of that day or two (2) hours after the end of that TCU football game.
- No commercial use of the designated parking space(s) shall be allowed.
- Vehicles must be kept within the boundaries of the designated parking space(s). Any tailgating activities must be immediately behind or in front of my vehicle. Tailgating equipment must not block other parking spots, traffic access ways, or fire lanes in the Season Parking Lot or adjacent public streets or walkways.
- All applicable present and future laws, ordinances, orders, rules and regulations of any local, state or federal governmental authorities will be enforced.
- Please be respectful of the fact that the Season Parking Lots are part of the property of University United Methodist Church. TCU football games are normally on Saturdays and church services are held the following day. Please keep your space clean and remove any trash generated by you and your guests.
- Individuals providing access to the Season Parking Lots are not employees of UUMC or TCU but are adults and youth volunteering their time to raise funds for the Children, Youth, and Church Ministries of UUMC. Please remember to treat them with respect and consideration.
